**Note: Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers: Bowing toward the Tabernacle**

**Lectors:** When processing down the aisle towards the altar and placing the "Gospel Readings Book" on the altar, please do not turn around and bow toward the tabernacle before taking your seat. Also, do not turn around and bow towards the tabernacle after any of the readings; First, Second, Prayers for the Faithful or Second Collection.

**Eucharistic Ministers:** When you reach the altar area (to distribute either the Body or Blood of Christ) please do not turn towards the tabernacle and bow, either before or after distributing communion.

Bowing toward the tabernacle is a sign of respect when Mass is not being said. When mass is being said, our focus is on the altar. Thanks....

**Note: Eucharistic Ministers: A few requests regarding the distribution of the Blood of Christ:**

We have received some concerns from some parishioners regarding our wiping of the cup(s) when we distribute the Blood of Christ. The concern is that we are not wiping the cup properly with the purificator.

The proper procedure is the following:

The extraordinary minister will raise the cup, and say in a clear voice, "The Blood of Christ." (The communicant should respond "Amen.")

After each communicant receives from the cup, the minister then wipes the cup's rim (inside and out), using the purificator. Then, before presenting the cup to the next person, he or she will turn the cup slightly (about a quarter of a turn).

When wiping the cup's rim, please make sure that you wipe **both the outer and inner rim of the cup**. Further, please use a clean portion of the purificator. One that DOES NOT have some of the blood from previous cup wipings.

We live in an era of great concern about getting ill, so we ask everyone's cooperation in not detracting from the spirit of receiving the Blood of Christ.

An added note: Please DO NOT insert the purificator in the cup to "soak up" any Blood of Christ which is remaining. Any remains will be consumed by the sacristans, or disposed of correctly.

This might require you to sacrifice your own personal taste or devotional practices in a spirit of service to the community.
